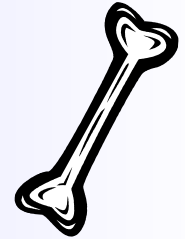
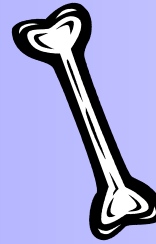

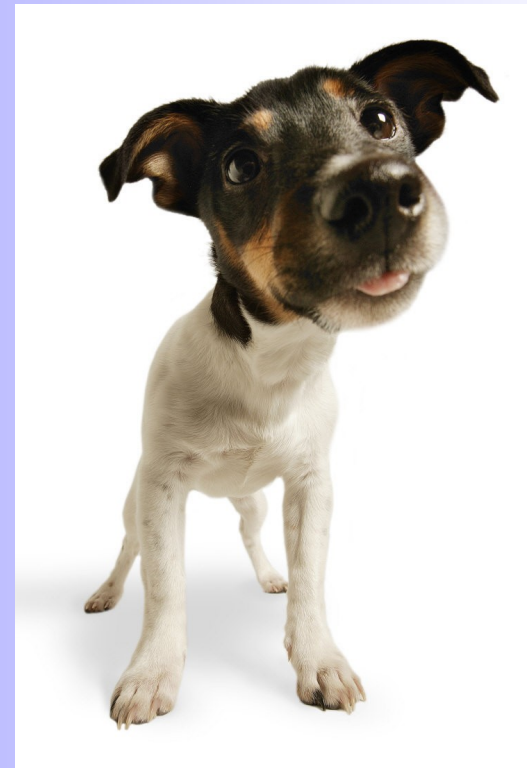

The Re-homing Scheme is run by a team of volunteers in the Worcestershire area, who help with such duties as home checking, fund-raising and publicity, and all the paperwork administration.

The Re-homing programme is now firmly established, with hundreds of dogs having been re-homed since 1992.

We pay private boarding kennels for the care of each dog. In addition there are veterinary fees for neutering, vaccination and micro-chipping.

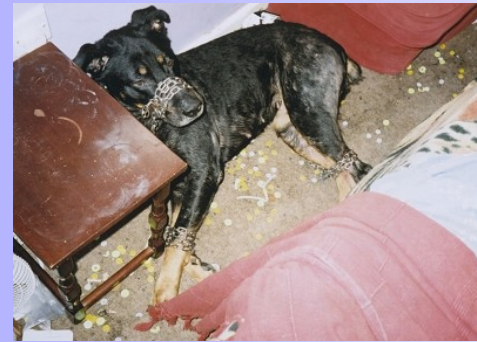

JESS'S STORY

Jess was found in 2004 after an Inspector followed a complaint that a dog could be heard whimpering in a one-bedroom property.

She was found with chains round her mouth, front and back legs, and she was unable to walk, eat or drink.

With the assistance of police, Jess was removed from the property and taken to a veterinary surgeon for examination. Jess had a severe skin condition as well as sores, bald patches of hair and irritated skin caused by the chains that bound her.

With the help of volunteers at the RSPCA Worcester and Mid-Worcestershire branch, Jess went on to receive the care and vital medical attention she needed to make a full recovery.
